Events: Foil, Epée and Sabre – U10, U12, Seniors

Eligibility: All competitors for U10 and U12 must be under the respective age on 1 January 2020 and any ages 12+ can compete in the Seniors. All competitors must hold a valid British Fencing membership number. More details on how to sign up for British Fencing membership here: <http://www.britishfencing.com/membership/>

Entry Fee: £10 per event, late entries are £15 per event and may be rejected at the discretion of the organisers.

Closing Date: Friday 4th December 2020. The closing date will be strictly applied.

Format:

U10, U12 These events will have mixed poules.

Seniors Senior events will have mixed poules but then a separate tableau will be drawn up for the direct eliminations.

The organising committee reserves the right to alter the format of any or all age group events to suit entries and conditions on the day.

Safety and Kit: Full kit safety checks may be carried out at any time during the competition.

Competitors must have appropriate non-marking sole footwear with long socks, fencing jackets and breeches (minimum 350N), under-plastrons (minimum 800N), fencing glove and mask (minimum 350N) with back strap, bib straps for Leon Paul contour fit masks are not required. Fencers in U10, U12 events must use size 2 épées and sabres and size 3 foils. Fencers should also be prepared for weapon tests. Foil bibs are not required in U10, U12 Foil.

Terms

Please read the following terms carefully. Please keep a copy for your records.

Each Fencer (or if under 18 years of age, the relevant parent or carer of such Fencer):

1. agrees that taking part in any activity with Guernsey En Garde requires the Fencer to behave responsibly;
2. will be liable for any costs arising from any irresponsible or unlawful behaviour and acts;
3. will be liable for any damage to the Guernsey Badminton Association property through irresponsible behaviour or the wearing of incorrect footwear (NB non-marking footwear to be worn);
4. agrees to receiving medication as instructed by any medical authorities present and any emergency dental, medical or surgical treatment, including anaesthetic or blood transfusion, as considered necessary by medical authorities present;
5. accepts that there is no Guernsey En Garde medical insurance and understands the extent and limitations of the BRITISH FENCING insurance cover and that a copy of the policy is available at www.britishfencing.com;
6. accepts liability for all costs arising from the instructions given to maintain the health and well-being of myself or my child (whichever is applicable) by representatives of Guernsey En Garde. Where applicable every effort shall be made to keep parents or carers informed and minimise costs arising. Membership of St John's Ambulance in Guernsey is recommended;
